

Greenlee County Recorder VOTER REGISTRATION

Proposition 200, passed by voters of Arizona at the 2004 General Election, became effective January 24, 2005. ALL NEW voter registration forms must be accompanied with satisfactory evidence of United States Citizenship, which includes one of the following:

- An Arizona driver's license or non-operating identification license number, issued after 10/01/1996.
- A driver's license or non-operating identification license number from another state that identified United States Citizenship.
- A legible photocopy of a birth certificate with the name of the applicant that verified United States Citizenship.
- A legible photocopy of the pertinent pages of a United States passport.
- A copy of United States naturalization documents or number of the certification of naturalization.
- Bureau of Indian Affairs Card Number, Tribal Treaty Card Number or Tribal Enrollment Number.

Your name cannot be added to the voter registration file until we have received the required information. In order to be eligible to vote in an election, a completed voter registration form and required proof of citizenship must be received in our office no later than 29 days prior to the election.

REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTERING TO VOTE OR UPDATING YOUR EXISTING REGISTRATION

- A citizen of United States.
- 18 Years of age or older preceding the next general election.
- A resident of the state 29 days preceding the next general election.
- Have not been convicted of a felony or treason, if so, your civil rights have been restored.
- You have moved.
- You changed your name.
- Signature Required

When registering to vote for the first time or when updating your existing voter registration, Arizona voters will now have the ability to opt-in to receive a state-issued publicity pamphlet by email verses traditional U. S. Postal mail service. Voters must complete the entire voter registration process through ServiceArizona in order to sign-up for the pamphlet and will receive a confirmation email indicating all registration preferences selected including their opt-in selection.
