March 5, 2012

The Greenlee County Board of Supervisors met on this date in special session in telephonic and video presence in the Board Meeting Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Courthouse Annex, Clifton, Arizona, with the following members present: Richard Lunt, Chairman (telephonic); David Gomez, Member (Video); and Ron Campbell, Member (Video). Present was Yvonne Pearson, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Lunt called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Yvonne Pearson, Elections Director, presented the canvass of the 2012 Presidential Preference Election. She stated that Greenlee County had 38.88% of the registered voters turning out to vote. 173 ballots were cast at the polls and 242 Early Ballots were cast. She stated that Republicans cast 190 votes for Mitt Romney, 132 votes for Rick Santorum, 48 votes for Newt Gingrich, 39 votes for Ron Paul and 2 votes each for Cesar Cisneros, Rick Perry, Michael Levinson and 1 vote for Sarah Gonzales. There were no votes cast for the Green Party candidates for President. She expressed appreciation to the polls workers who did an excellent job making sure that voters were able to cast their votes on Election Day. Upon motion by Supervisor Gomez, seconded by Supervisor Campbell, and carried unanimously, the Board canvassed the returns of the 2012 Presidential Preference Election as presented. The complete abstract of the official canvass will appear at the end of this days proceeding.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Supervisors, the meeting was adjourned at 8:34 a.m.
