With recent news that FMI may soon be furloughing and laying off workers in Morenci, I'm concerned that people who were living in Greenlee on April 1, 2020 (Census Day) may be soon leaving town and heading off to various unknown places. As of 4-27-20, Greenlee had the fourth-lowest response rate in the state (23.5%). Only Apache, La Paz and Navajo Counties had lower response rates. Our response rate so far is approximately half of what it was in 2010 (45.4%). Obviously, we are looking at a devastating blow to Greenlee's economy with such a dreadful undercount.

To help counteract this, I'm wondering is whether there may be a way to track the people who leave FMI housing between now and when the final census count is due on 10-31-20? I would imagine that since it involves company housing, the company could provide us with that data. Of course that won't help us track people leaving who don't live in FMI housing, but that would be harder to do and should be a much smaller number.

I know we are all concerned about the effect of COVID-19 on Greenlee's employment numbers, which is something we can't do anything about at this time. However, any way that we can bring our Census numbers up seems like something we should pursue if we can. Thank you for your attention to this matter.

MEMORANDUM REGARDING AUSTERITY MEASURES TO REDUCE BUDGET RISK

Prepared for the Board of Supervisors 5/5/2020

Recommended Measures to be Taken Immediately:

- 1. Require all offices both Elected Officials and appointed Department Heads to review ALL expenditures for necessity. If it is determined that an expenditure is not a current necessity, can it be delayed? Will there be a dollar cost associated with delay (e.g. contract penalty)? Can the purchase or contract be pushed into the next fiscal year?
- 2. Require that all capital expenditures in excess of \$2,000 be placed on the regular agenda instead of the consent agenda for board review. Elected Officials and Department Heads must present their request and justify the expense. This policy will not apply to ongoing expenses such as cleaning supplies or other items that where there is an ongoing contractual relationship with a vendor for regular purchases to support ongoing operations.
- All Departments and Elected Official's offices should stop all unnecessary travel outside the county. Utilization of video-conferencing or teleconferencing should be used in place of in-person meetings wherever possible to limit travel.
- 4. If in-person attendance at meetings is required, all offices and departments are required to use county vehicles instead of personal vehicles as a cash saving measure unless specific circumstances do not allow for use of a county vehicle. Use of non-county vehicles must be specifically approved by the Elected Official or Department Head.
- 5. Board must specifically approve, prior to advertising, the filling of all vacancies. Positions not currently filled should be reviewed prior to the end of the budget year to determine if the position should be budgeted for in the coming fiscal year. The burden of scheduling a review to fill a vacancy will be upon the Elected Official or Department Head.
- 6. Overtime, should be kept to a minimum and should only be utilized to meet emergency needs. As in the past, paid overtime will only be available for nursing staff or other health department personnel directly associated with COVID-19 prevention and/or control and sheriff's office personnel. Overtime, that is

compensated as comp time should also be kept to minimum with prior approval of Elected Official or Department Head. While this is the current policy, it should be re-emphasized at this time. Emergencies that are declared disasters do not fall under this policy. Each department should review all employee compensatory time balances and develop a plan to reduce this liability as quickly as possible without unreasonable impact on ongoing operations.

7. Delay capital purchases of vehicles for sheriff's office, fleet, and road department to FY 20-21.

Recommendations to be considered for FY 20-21

- Delay vehicle purchases in FY 20-21 until the late spring prior to the end of the budget year or until revenues have sufficiently recovered as determined by the Board. Continue to obtain Board approval prior to going out for bids for vehicle purchases.
- 2. Continue use of previous levels of Secure Rural Schools funding for the Road Department budget but reduce contributions to the Road fund from General Fund and other sources as will be presented in budget proposals for the FY 20-21 budget. These measures are designed to give sufficient funding to maintain the county road system with minimal impact on the General Fund.
- Work actively with our legislative delegation, other small counties, the County Supervisors Association and Arizona Association of Counties to anticipate, address and limit cost shifts from the State to County Government.
- 4. As the majority of grants now require matching funds and/or require proof of appropriate expenditures before reimbursement from the grant agency is dispersed, Greenlee County's Grant Policy must be re-emphasized which requires specific Board approval prior to applying for any grant funding. The policy addresses the process of applying for grants as well as matching funds and the need to provide General Fund dollars for grants that are reimbursable only. Departments requesting to apply for grants must provide a cost/benefit analysis of the grant including the administrative burden of the grant and the risk of non-reimbursement for failure to adequately account for expenditures. Administrative costs incurred by the finance department should be charged to the grant and/or the department receiving the grant.
- 5. Continue with regularly scheduled computer rotation plans and IT infrastructure upgrades, particularly those IT components that will ensure network cybersecurity. This has proven in past financial crises to be a cost-saving measure. All departments have demands that require computer and internet capabilities in order to meet their mandates. Staying on a rotation limits the amount of money we expend in a single year.

- Review non-mandated budgeted transfers such as to the Landfill Development and Closure Fund, Economic Development Fund and Debt Service Fund. Delay and review all such transfers not already made prior to the end of the current fiscal year and consider delaying such transfers in FY 20-21 until the end of that fiscal year.
- 7. Review sales/severance tax revenue estimates after receiving the May appropriations. Depending on the severity of revenue reductions in May, consider more austere budget reductions for the current fiscal year. This process must be repeated for the June appropriations as this trend will inform the revenue trend in the first and second quarter of FY 20-21 and may implicate more severe cost containing measures in FY 20-21.

1.) Call to Order

Supervisor Lunt called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m.

A. Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisor David Gomez led those present in the pledge of allegiance.

B. Call to the Public

Daniel Cervantes, Clifton Resident, responded to Call to the Public. Mr. Cervantes thanked the board and handling the meetings and making it easy for the public to attend with the COVID – 19 pandemic.

Mr. Sumner responded to Call of the Public stated he is pleased that an employee in the Boards Office who has been more than deserving of a title change has been given a raise and the new title. 3.) Tony Hines, Public Works Manager – Fleet/Facilities
A. Discussion/Action regarding purchase for Playground equipment for York Park

Mr. Hines presented to the board quotes for playground equipment for the York park. Mr. Hines stated the recommended company has the same playground equipment set in Loma Linda and Duncan parks. He stated his recommendation is Triple M Recreation #2 in the amount of \$49,957.89.

Mr. Cervantes responded to this item and stated Mr. Power's letter of resignation came to a surprise to him. He stated he has known Mr. Powers for decades since he started teaching at Morenci Schools.

Mr. Powers gave his appreciation to the board. He stated the loved he had for his job and that Greenlee County is a great place to raise a family.

Mr. Campbell gave his appreciation to Mr. Tom Powers and gave his thanks for everything he's done with Greenlee County Schools. Mr. Campbell stated how special Mr. Powers is to the kids and community.

Mr. Gomez echoed Mr. Campbell. He stated how much he appreciates Mr. Powers who's been involved in the schools and community.

Mr. Lunt stated he's known Mr. Powers for many years. He stated he's been special to his family. Mr. Lunt wishes Mr. Powers and his family the best of luck.

Upon motion by Supervisor Campbell, seconded by Supervisor Gomez, and carried unanimously, the Board approved the letter of resignation as presented.

B. Discussion/Action regarding appointment of Bryan Boling to fill vacancy as County School Superintendent

Mr. Cervantes spoke on this item. He stated his concerns regarding the vacancy of the County School Superintendent

Mr. Campbell asked if anyone else from the public filed a candidate packet for the School Superintendent. Ms. Figueroa Elections Director, and Mr. Rapier County Administrator affirmed that no one else filed other than Mr. Bryan Boiling. Upon motion by Supervisor Gomez, seconded by Supervisor Campbell, and carried unanimously, the Board approved appointment of Bryan Boling to fill vacancy as County School Superintendent effective July 1, 2020.

5.) Derek Rapier, County Administrator, Discussion and Possible Adoption of Fair Housing Resolution

Mr. Rapier stated housing has been on the top of the County's priority list. He stated the resolution is a simple restatement of what the county has always believed in. However, adopting the resolution may better position the county to receive federal COVID relief funding.

6.) Derek Rapier, County Administrator A. County and State budget and legislative issues

Mr. Rapier states the legislature has recessed due to COVID-19. He stated the Legislature talked about going back into session in mid-April, however, due to COVID cases still increasing the legislature would come back at a later date. Mr. Rapier stated there were about 600 bills that were not finished and only a few signed by the Govern, most of the bills would not be heard when the legislature returns.

Mr. Sumer requested to speak on this item. He stated in his preparing his budget, on March 24th he requested public records for information pertaining to budget items. He was directed to talk to the County Administrator.
