The Greenlee County Board of Supervisors met on this date in special session with the following members present: Richard Lunt, Chairman; David Gomez, Member; and Ron Campbell, Member. Also present were Deborah K. Gale, County Administrator, and Yvonne Pearson, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Lunt called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. in the Board Meeting Room, 2nd floor Courthouse Annex, Clifton, Arizona.

The Board convened into Public Hearing regarding the Redistricting of the County Supervisor Districts. Ms. Pearson stated that pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes §11-212, the Board of Supervisors are required to divide the county as nearly equal in population as practicable into supervisor districts on or before December 1. She presented information showing the necessity to realign the boundaries and presented proposed preliminary maps. The Board reviewed the information and maps. The public hearing was published and posted as required. There were no persons from the public in attendance and no comments have been received regarding the redistricting.

The Board recessed the meeting in Clifton at 3:00 p.m. and reconvened at the County Fairgrounds Duncan at 6:00 p.m. to continue the Public Hearing for public review and comment regarding the Redistricting of County Supervisor Districts. The public hearing was published and posted as required. There were no persons from the public in attendance and no comments have been received regarding the redistricting.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Supervisors, the meeting was adjourned at 6:30 p.m.
