

GREENLEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
CLIFTON, ARIZONA

September 19, 2014

The Greenlee County Board of Supervisors met in Emergency Session in the Board Meeting Room, 2nd floor Courthouse Annex, Clifton, Arizona, with the following Board members present: David Gomez, Chairman; Ron Campbell, Member; and Robert Corbell, Member. Also present were Deborah K. Gale, County Administrator, and Yvonne Pearson, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Gomez called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

Ms. Gale requested approval of the Cooperation Agreement with the United States of America Department of the Army for Emergency Assistance (Flood or Coastal Storm). She stated that the Arizona Division of Emergency Management and Army Corp of Engineers should have presented and had this agreement in place before beginning any work in Duncan in response to the potential flooding due to remnants of Hurricane Odile. Work will not continue until the agreement is signed. Approximately \$700,000.00 has been released by the federal government for the Corp of Engineers to complete the project.

Derek Rapiet, County Attorney, recommended that the Board sign the agreement and let the project continue.

Supervisor Campbell expressed his appreciation for the immediate response of the Corp of Engineers and their assistance in helping keep our citizens safe.

Upon motion by Supervisor Campbell, seconded by Supervisor Corbell, and carried unanimously, the Board approved the agreement as presented.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Supervisors the Emergency Session was adjourned at 1:10 p.m.
