The Greenlee County Board of Supervisors met on this date in Special Session in the Board Meeting Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Courthouse Annex, Clifton, Arizona, with the following members present telephonically: David Gomez, Chairman; Ron Campbell, Member; and Robert Corbell, Member.
