## GREENLEE COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CLIFTON, ARIZONA

## September 30, 2015

The Greenlee County Board of Supervisors met on this date in Special session in the Board Meeting Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor Courthouse Annex, Clifton, Arizona, with the following members present: David Gomez, Chairman (telephonically); Ron Campbell, Member; and Robert Corbell, Member. Also present were Deborah K. Gale, County Administrator, and Yvonne Pearson, Clerk of the Board.

Chairman Gomez called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m. and Supervisor Campbell led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Board convened into Work Session regarding participation in El Moro de Cumpas or consideration of the sale of county horse race dates. Ms. Gale stated that she has some questions that need to be answered on the funding of horse races in the Spring. Supervisor Campbell expressed concerns stating that the County is not prepared to have horse races in April 2016. He does not want the races to fail and feels that the County needs more time to prepare and be successful and sell the race dates to help with funding. Supervisors Corbell and Gomez echoed the concerns of Supervisor Campbell and both agreed that racing should be postponed to 2017 to be better prepared.

The Board reconvened into special session.

Supervisor Campbell moved to sell Greenlee County's horse race dates for April 2016 and move forward with cost estimates to make the necessary facility repairs needed to be able to race in 2017. Supervisor Corbell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Supervisors, the meeting was adjourned at 4:30 p.m.
