



Franklin-Duncan Watershed Plan/Environmental Assessment

In 2020, Greenlee County received funds through the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Watershed Flood Prevention and Operations Program to develop a watershed plan and Environmental Assessment (EA) to assess the watershed and determine actions that will help alleviate problems in flood prone areas in the Franklin-Duncan Watershed.

The purpose of the proposed project is to prevent damages from floodwaters, erosion, and sediment. All reasonable alternatives will be considered during development of the Plan/EA, including improving drainage structures, construction of infiltration or detention systems to slow runoff, and other potential measures designed to reduce erosion and sediment damages.

You are invited to attend a public meeting and provide input. The range of resource issues and conceptual alternatives addressing potential flood protection improvements to the project focus area will be presented and discussed.

Comments submitted during this scoping period of June 14 to July 14, 2021, will be used in the development of a draft Watershed Plan-EA. Please submit any comments during this time. The public will have another opportunity to review the draft plan and provide additional input before they are finalized.


